Sub: EXPEDITIOUS DISPOSAL OF CASES

Hon'ble Federal Tax Ombudsman has recently issued instructions for quick and expeditious disposal of cases within 60 days as per provisions of section 11(1) of Federal Tax Ombudsman Ordinance, 2000. You are requested to convey to your members that in future only one or at the most two short adjournments will be allowed and that too upon most genuine grounds supported with adequate evidence. Where adjournment is sought by an advocate for appearing before Tribunal, High Court etc, the name of case, copies of the notices for the date must be furnished with application for adjournment failing which it shall not be considered. The Complainant has to collect all necessary material while submitting complaint and it should not be a problem to make compliance on due date which is invariably after at least 3 weeks of the filing of the complaint. All this is must for speedy justice which is the basic purpose of the FTO enactment.
