The Chief Commissioners-IR are requested to establish liaison with State Bank of Pakistan and authorized branches of National Bank of Pakistan to ensure transfer of tax collection by these branches on **30.06.2019** to the respective branches of State Bank of Pakistan on the same date so as to account for the same towards the collection for the month of **June, 2019** as per State Bank of Pakistan's letter dated 26.06.2019 (copy enclosed).

COLLECTION OF DUTIES & TAXES BY NBP ON 28TH, 29TH & 30TH JUNE, 2019

Pursuant to FBR's request for opening of banks' branches and extension in banking hours on 28th, 29th & 30th June 2019, following instructions regarding observance of banking hours are being issued for compliance to facilitate the taxpayers:

- i. The NBP branches and SBP-BSC field offices shall remain open for extended hours till 08:00 PM on June 28, 2019. The clearing instruments collected on June 28, 2019, shall be bifurcated into two batches i.e. batch-1 Instruments relating to Government (receipts & payments) and batch-2 other instruments. The batch-1 instruments shall be lodged for clearing on June 29, 2019, while batch-2 will be retained for clearing on July 2, 2019. The commercial banks are being advised accordingly.
- ii. On Saturday the June 29, 2019, the NBP branches and SBP-BSC field offices shall remain open for collection of FBR taxes / Government receipts only till 08:00 PM.
- iii. On Sunday the June 30, 2019, the NBP branches and SBP-BSC field offices, shall remain open only for collection of FBR taxes / Government receipts up to 08:00 PM. A **Special Clearing** shall be arranged by the NIFT at 07:00 PM and NBP shall settle the transactions with SBP BSC field offices / head office till 11:00 PM same day i.e. June 30, 2019.

It may please be noted that on 29th & 30th June 2019, the NBP branches and SBP-BSC field offices shall not execute any payment out of Government accounts *except such payments as relating to payment of FBR/Government taxes, and cheques relating to obligatory payments by the Defense Forces.*

Please ensure the meticulous compliance of the above.

- 3) The Director, Payment Systems Department, SBP with the request to arrange special clearing, on the above stated schedule, through NIFT on 30th June, 2019 for Government collections.
- 4) The Chief Information Officer, SBP with the request to direct the concerned to ensure availability of Globus for the said purpose.
- 5) The Managing Director, SBP-BSC Bank, Head Office, Karachi.
- 6) The President, National Bank of Pakistan, HO, I.I. Chandigarh Road, Karachi.
- 7) The Chairman, Revenue Division, FBR House, Constitution Avenue, Islamabad.
